What Happens if the Proposed Budget does not pass on June 18th?

If the budget is defeated for a second time, the Board of Education **must** adopt a contingency budget.

What is a Contingency Budget?

A contingent budget is restricted to ordinary contingent expenses. Ordinary contingent expenses are those necessary to provide the minimum services legally required to:

Operate and maintain school buildings and education programs;

Preserve the property of the District; and

Ensure the health & safety of students and staff.

Ordinary contingent expenses do <u>**not**</u> include the following: New Equipment
